

DESIGNATED SERVICE COORDINATOR WEBINAR TRAINING

Part II: December 15, 2011, Vision, by Mindy Ely, Hearing and Vision Early Intervention Outreach

Time: 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. both days

Description: This is a two-morning webinar with in-depth information about supporting families of infants and toddlers with hearing and/or vision loss.

Target audience: Designated Service Coordinators (DSC's) who have not previously taken the face-to-face DSC training held June 2009 or May 2010. There is a phone in option for this Webinar *however this will be a long distance call for you if you use this option.* Webinar audio set up requires built in or external speakers and microphone or headset. The webinars will be recorded. *(Space allowing, current DSC's who have previously attended the training are welcome to register. In this case, let us know in advance that you have previously taken the training so that priority can be given to new DSC's. If a DSC has attended the training 2 times during a single credential cycle she/he will not be able to use both certificates of attendance toward the 30-hour continuing professional education requirement as part of the renewal application.)*

Those attending from the same CFC are encouraged to log in at one station (using only 1 login). You are ideally registering for both mornings, however if you can only attend one, there will be a possibility of viewing the recorded missed Webinar at a later date.

Hand outs and EI credit: The training will use Hearing and Vision Service Guidelines as the required hand out for this training. 4 hours total EI credit.

(Both sets of Service Guidelines are currently being updated). Additional information about handouts and login will be emailed along with registration confirmation.

Prerequisite: DSC's complete two 20 minute on-line awareness modules as a prerequisite for this training: Service Coordinator Training: Serving Families of Children with Vision or dual Sensory Loss and Service Coordinator Training: Serving Families of Children with Hearing Loss. Each online module provides .5 credit in Atypical Development, .5 credit in Working with Families .
